„Synergien schaffen: MINT trifft Gender trifft MINT“

Friday, November 8th, 12:30-16:30

The success of interdisciplinary research is closely linked to a mutual understanding of the differences between specific cultures of disciplines. This matters for the divide of humanities and STEM as well as for disciplines in seemingly close connection to each other. Therefore, the dialogue across disciplinary cultures stands in focus of this conference. Prof. Dr. Martina Schraudner (Head of Gender and Diversity in Technology and Product Development, TU Berlin and Scientific Head of Fraunhofer CeRRI) and Prof. Dr. Martina Erlemann (Gender & Science Studies in Physics, FU Berlin) have been invited to deliver keynotes and will share their expertise on the issues of the audience.

The poster session will address research projects and alliances as well as other research endeavours involving participation of researchers at TU Braunschweig and allied researchers/research institutions focusing on the STEM-field (natural sciences, technology, engineering and mathematics). During the poster session (1 hour), researchers will present their projects and engage in discussions with the audience. The aim of these discussions is to identify links to the keynotes and possible starting points for interdisciplinary and gender-sensitive research that are a characteristic of excellent research.

The keynotes will be held in German. The poster session is bilingual, so feel free to give your poster presentation in English or German.

Aim of the poster session

Poster should give outlines of one's own research. They can stick to the disciplinary cultures, but can also try to be accessible for scientists from other research areas. They may also show the gender dimension of the project. Both can be open for discussion during the session – especially when submitting an existing poster that was not originally designed with these elements in mind.

Possible guiding questions for the posters could be:

- What is your current research about? What is new about it? What is the relevance for society as a whole?
- What connections do you have with other disciplines? What are common goals and what is left to expertise of one's own specialization? What is the collaboration based on? What are the requirements and challenges for cooperation?
- How does your research address [sex, gender or diversity dimensions](#)? Do they matter? Do they have no significance (so far)? What might be relevant in the future?

What can be submitted?

We look for existing as well as new posters that give outlines of one's own research or a research alliance in the STEM-field at TU Braunschweig and its partners in research alliances and clusters. We also encourage researchers from the humanities doing research on STEM-issues or being part of a research alliance/cluster to submit their work as well. Posters may already outline gender dimensions, but we also welcome submissions that are interested in receiving feedback on a possible gender dimension.

Format

The poster should be DIN A0. In accordance with sustainability, we encourage to participate with an already printed poster.
